Furthermore, he built his own cabins with an initial phase of 23 cabins at Fireside Resort-Jackson Hole. The feedback from the customers was overwhelmingly positive, so much that it launched Wheelhaus into the national spotlight as a premier tiny home and pre-fab modular builder. Finally, under Jamie's leadership, Fireside Resorts has experienced a twofold increase with a near-100% increase in net operating income over the last two years. On the other hand, Wheelhaus has seen substantial growth over the last few years with the manufacturing shop in Salt Lake City, Utah, and the recent expansion to a 50-acre site in Idaho Falls, Idaho.
